How was the sample designed?	Using the IEBC voter register, the sample was designed using Probability Proportional to Size (PPS).
Data Analysis	Data was processed and analyzed using SPSS 25

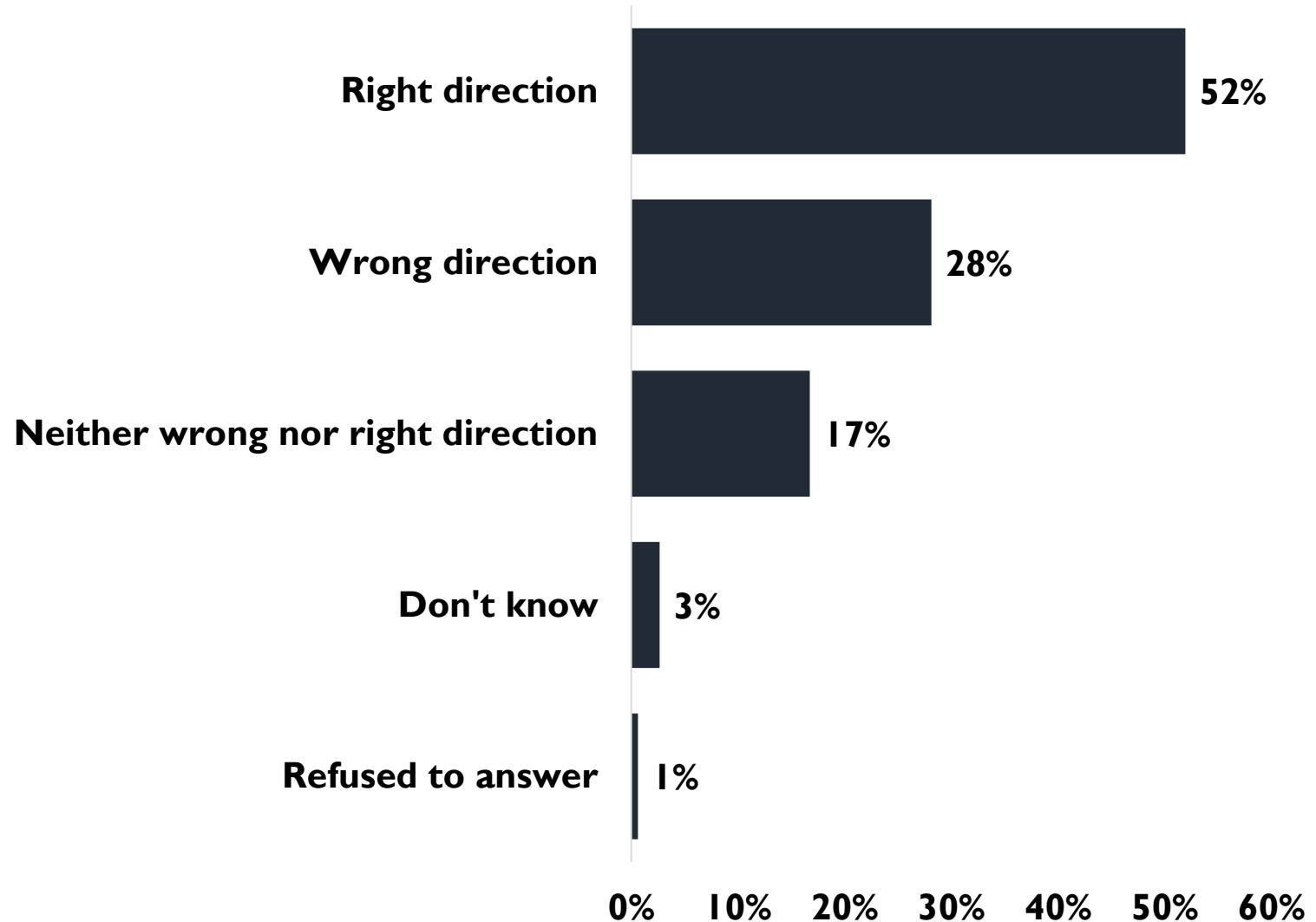

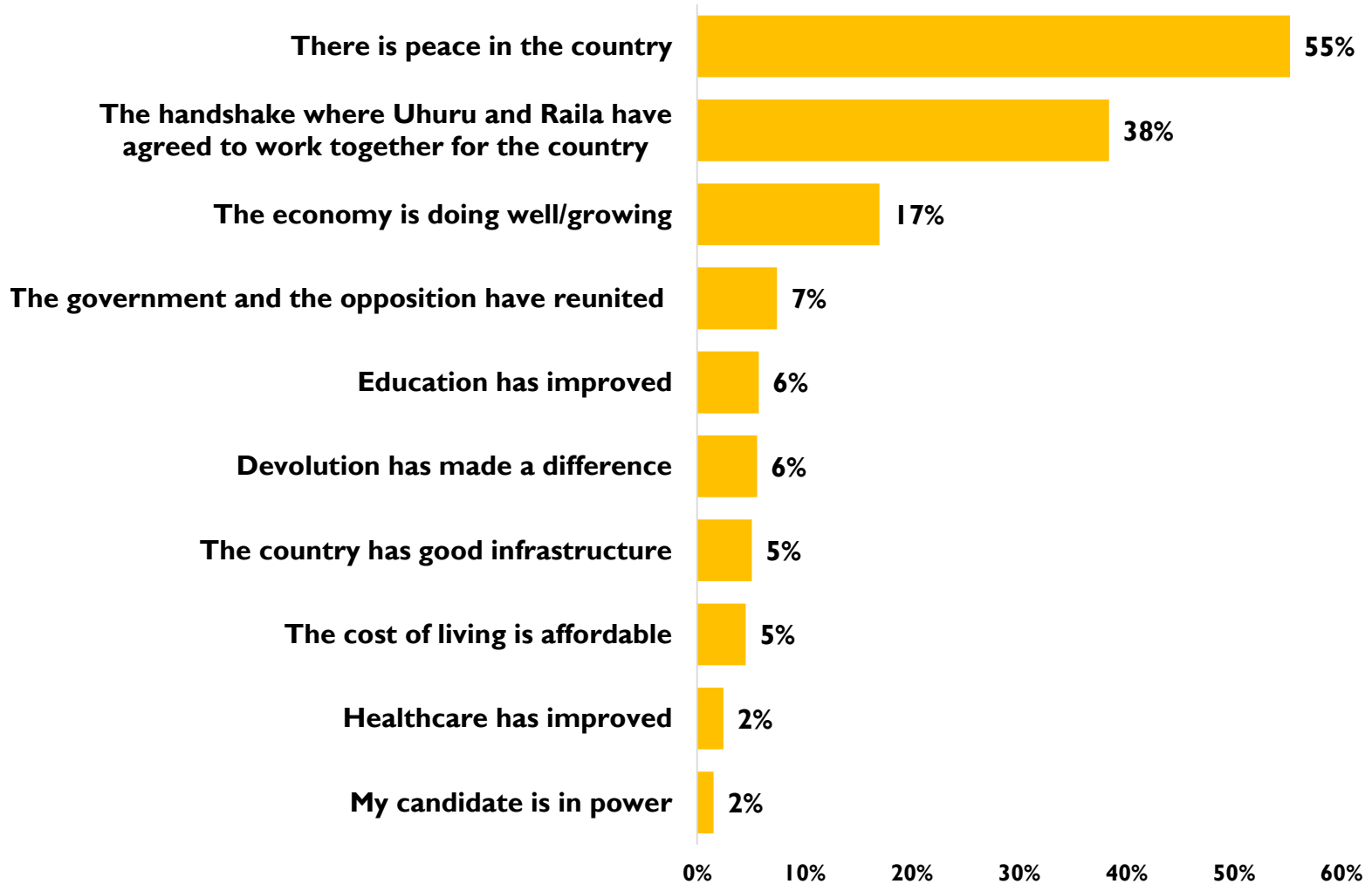

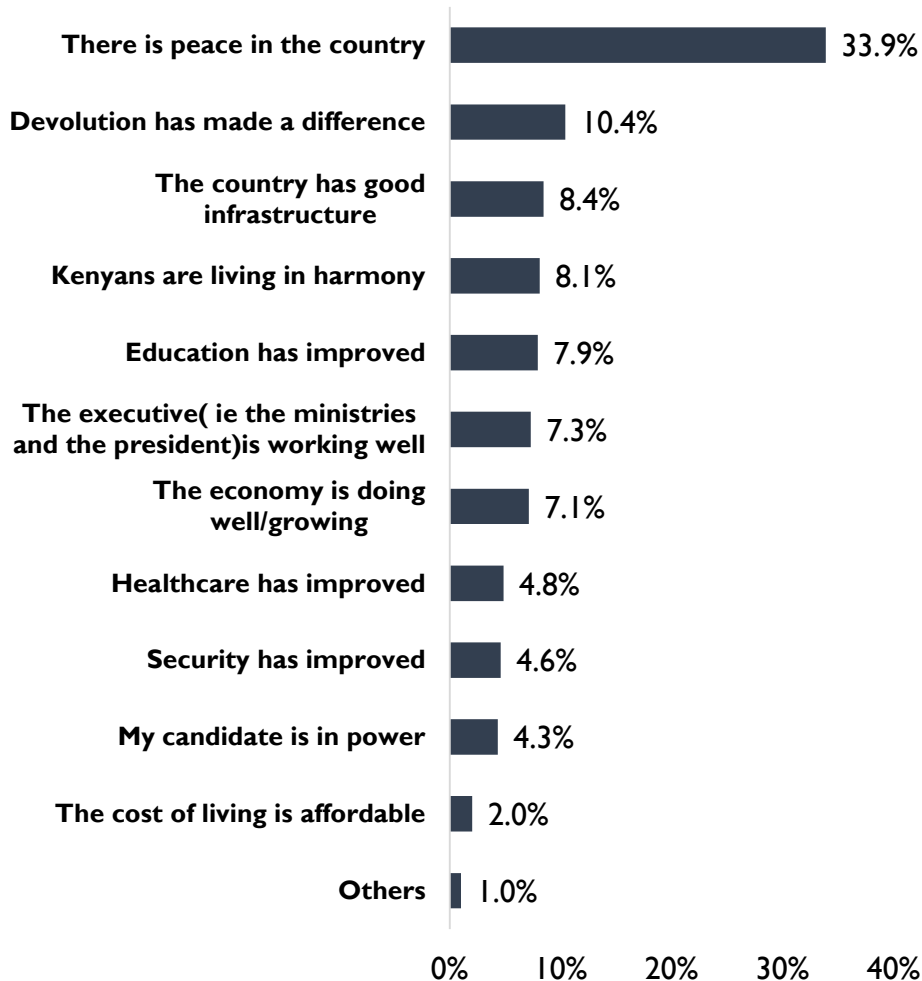


Generally, would you say Kenya is headed in the right direction?

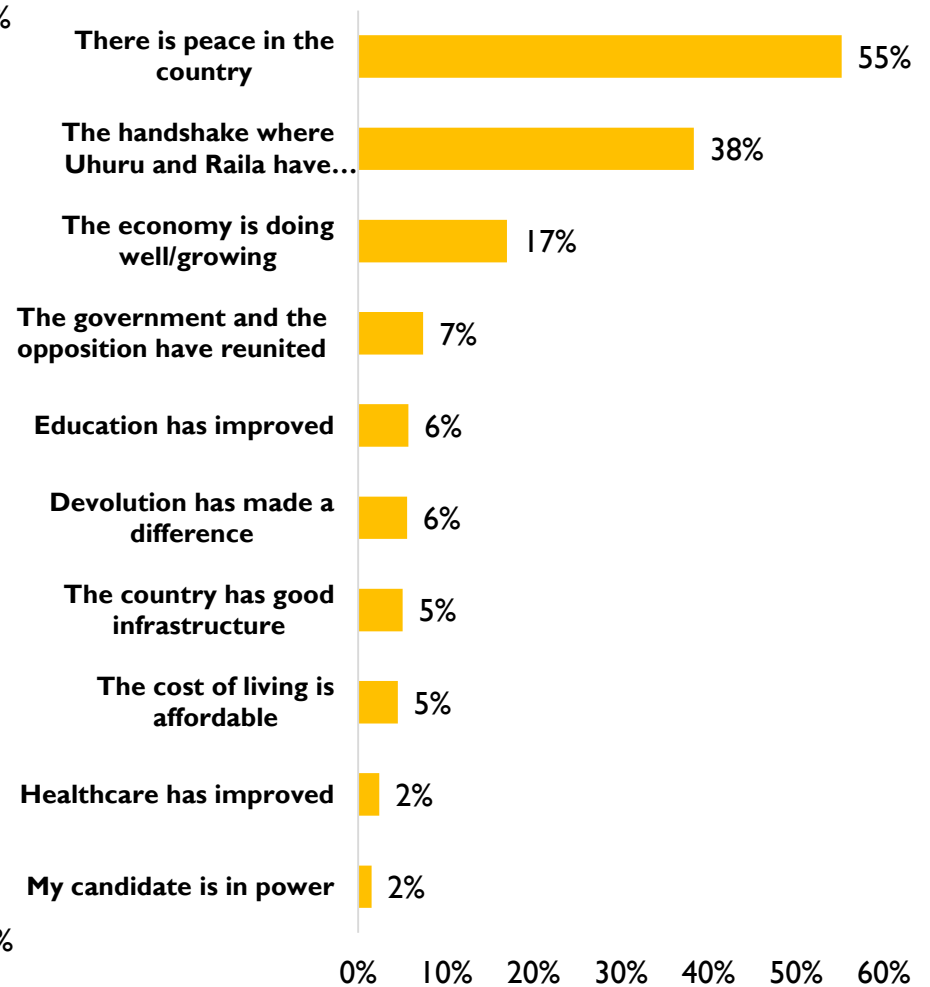

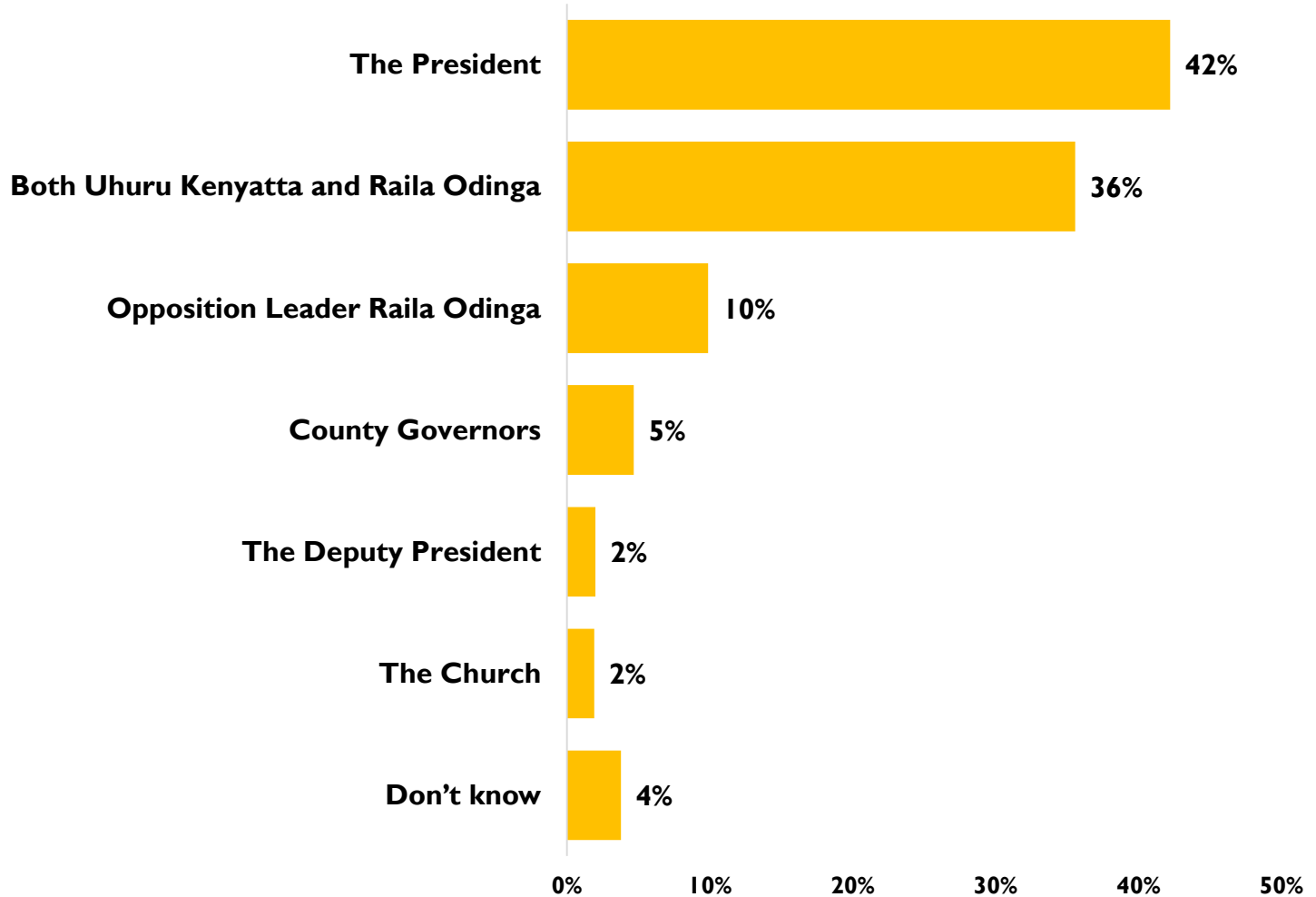

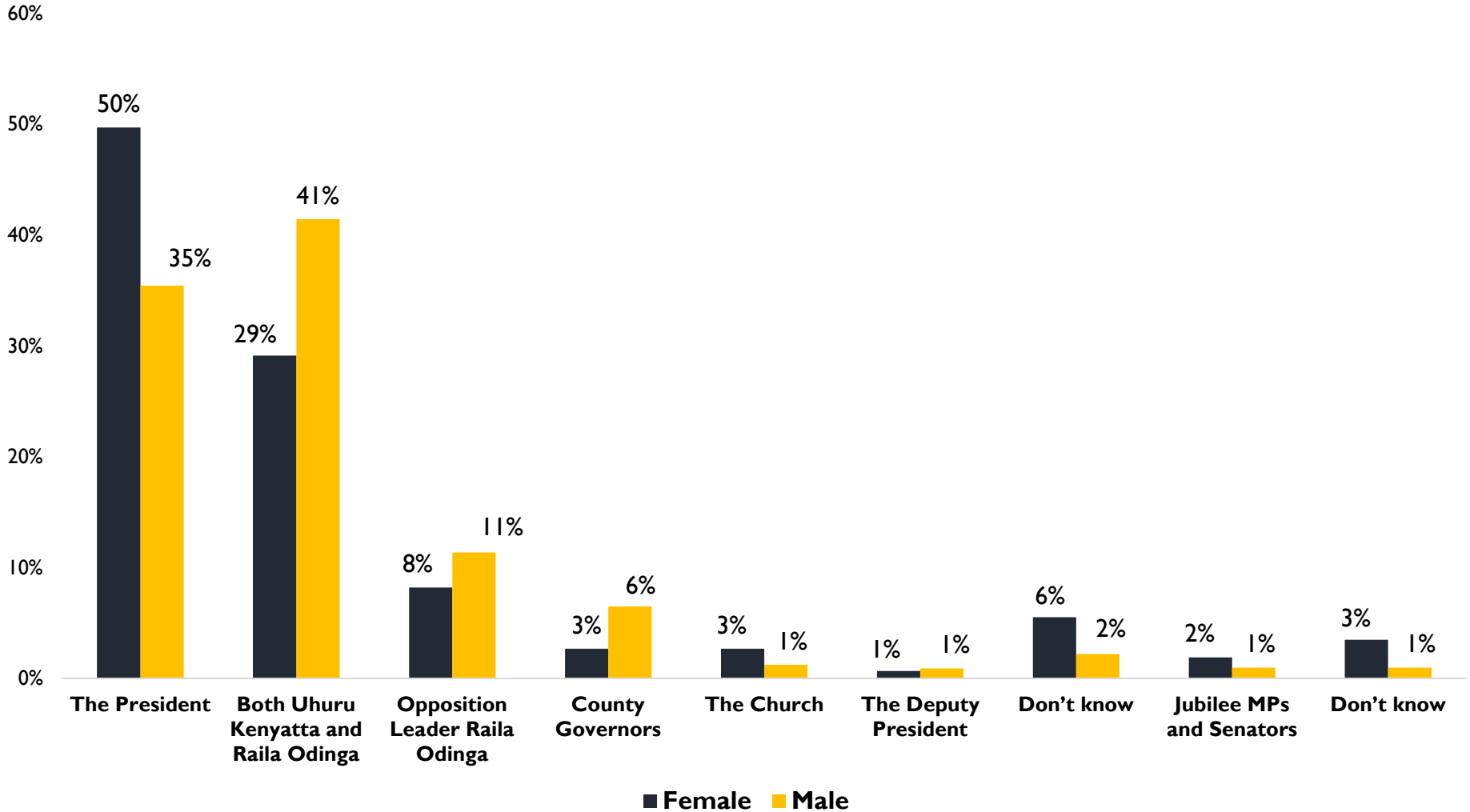

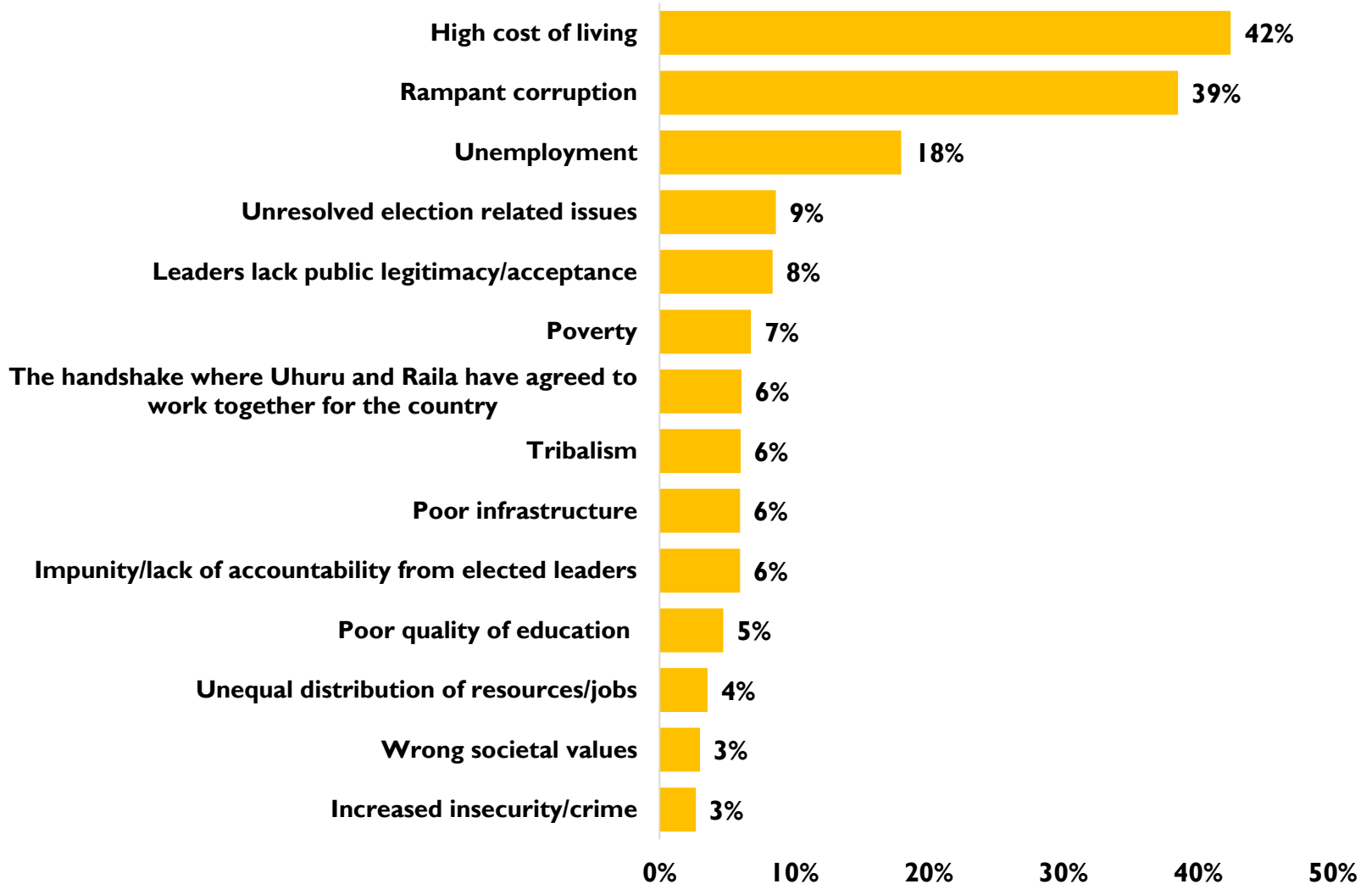

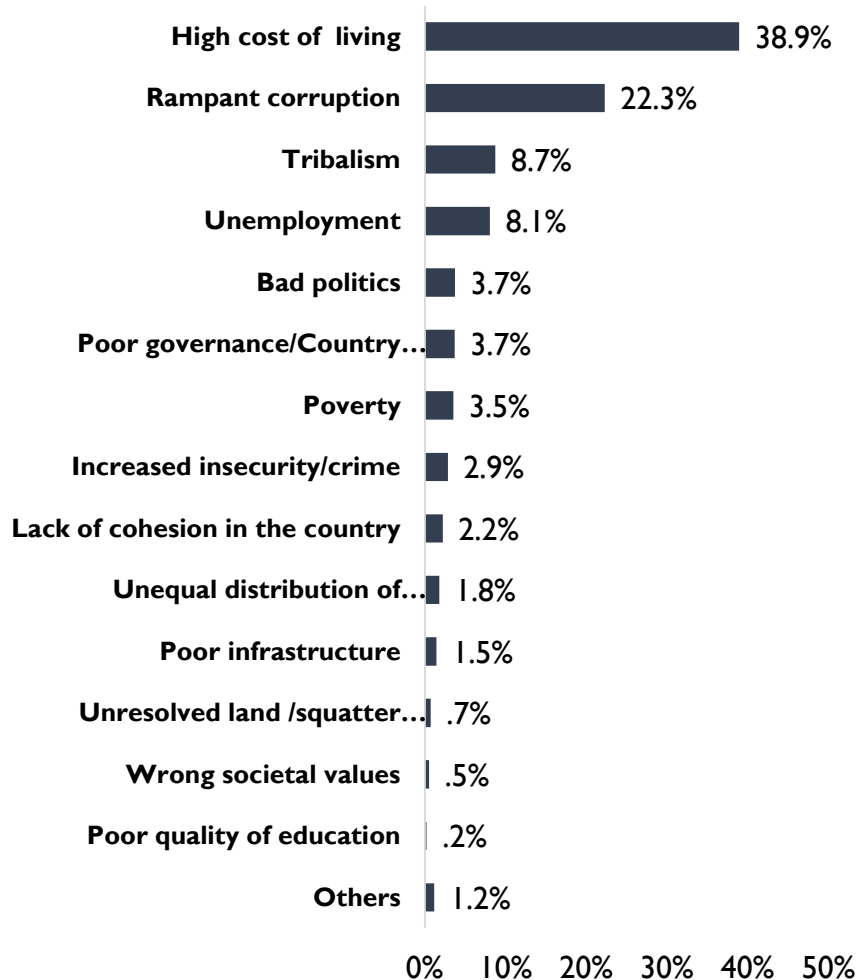

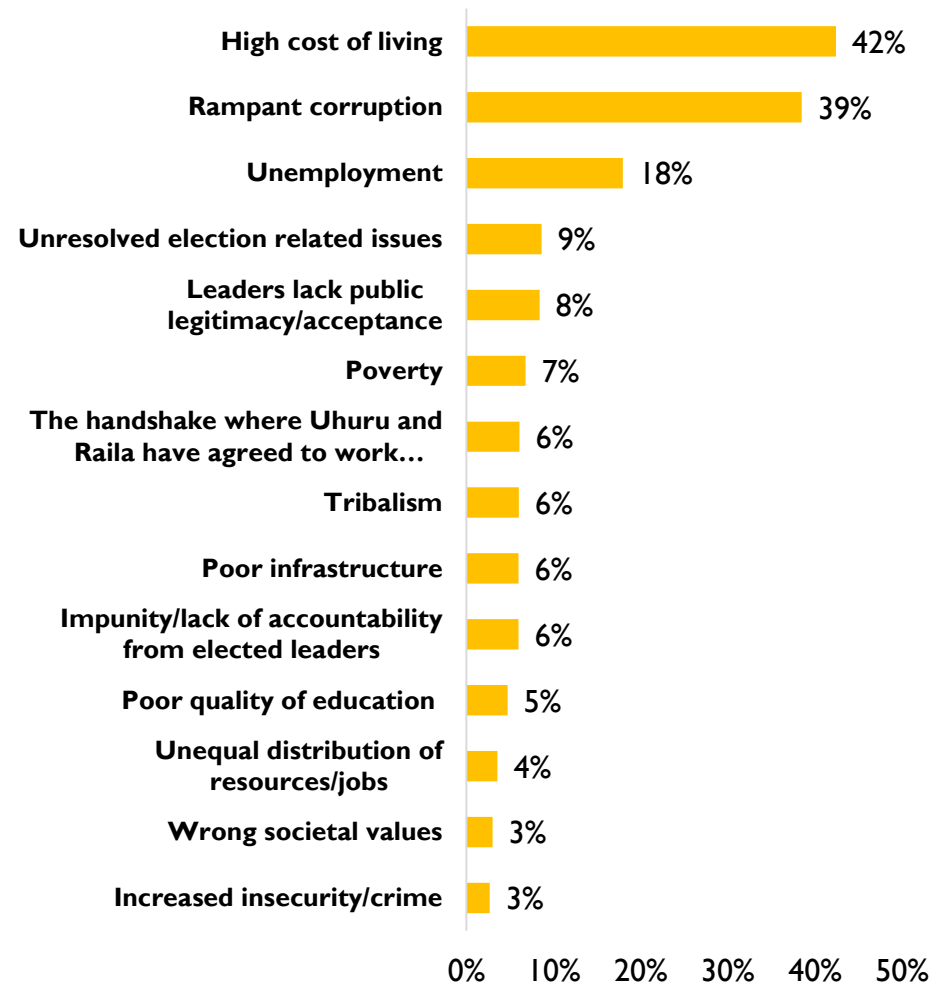

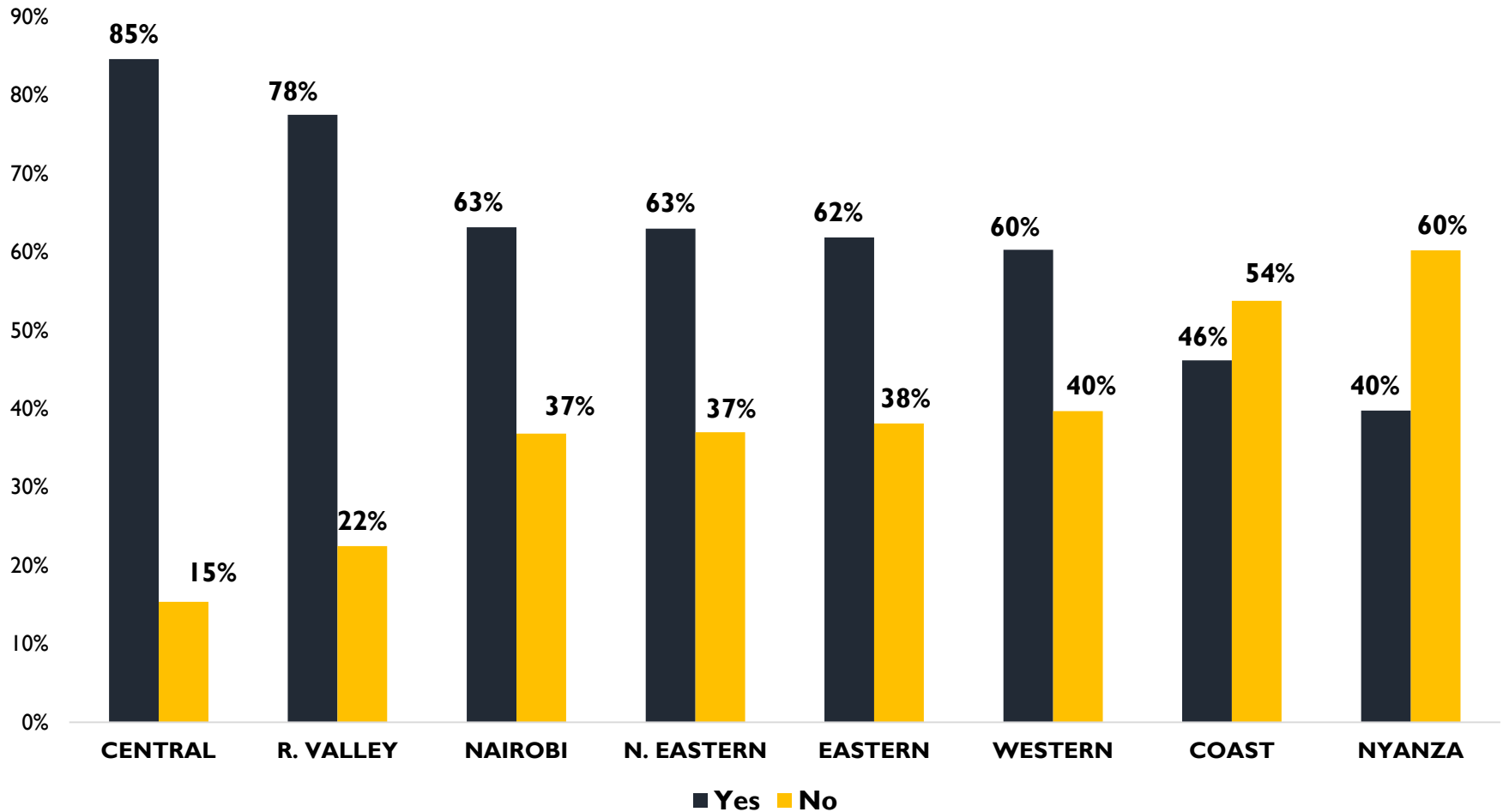

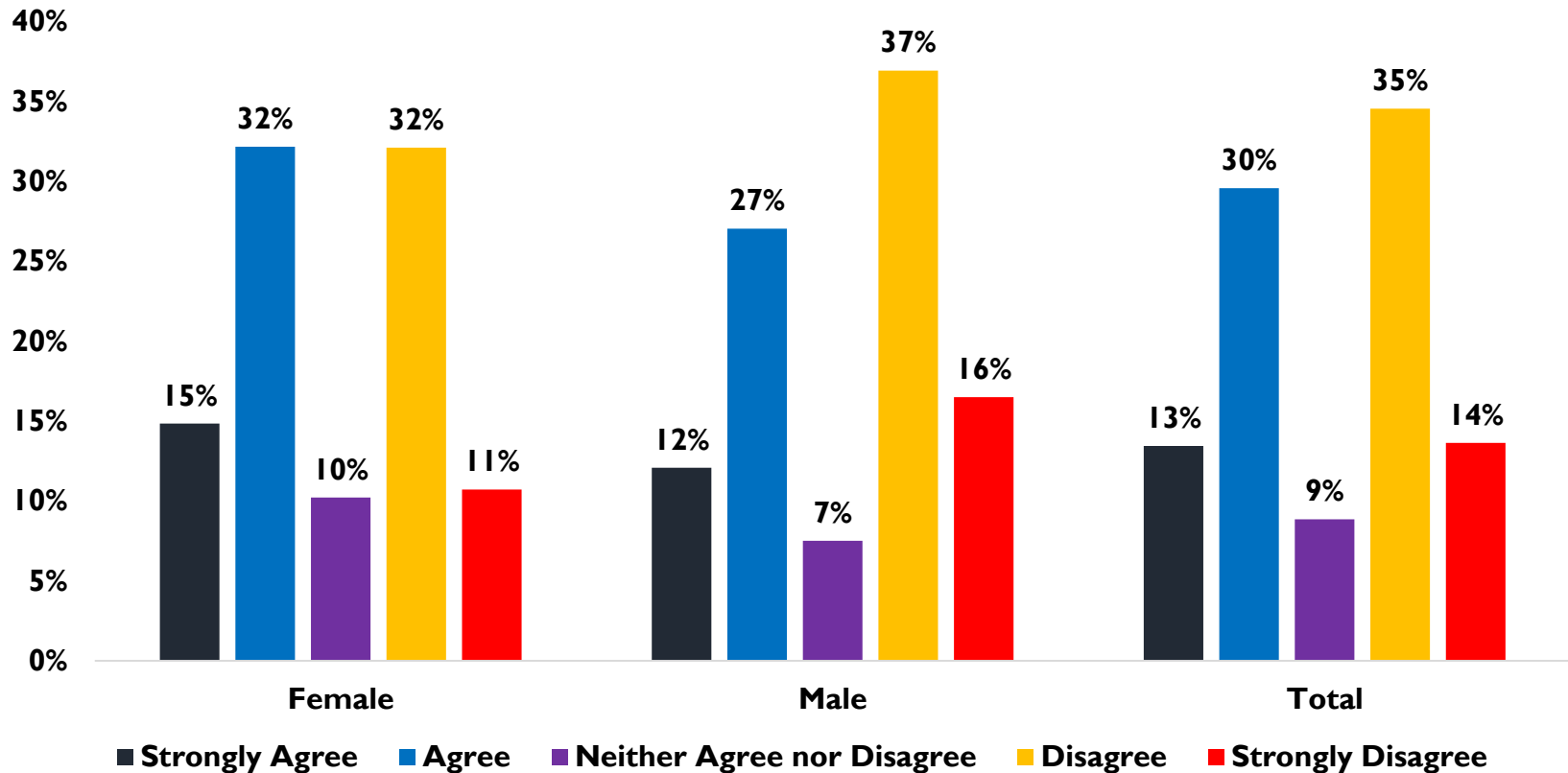

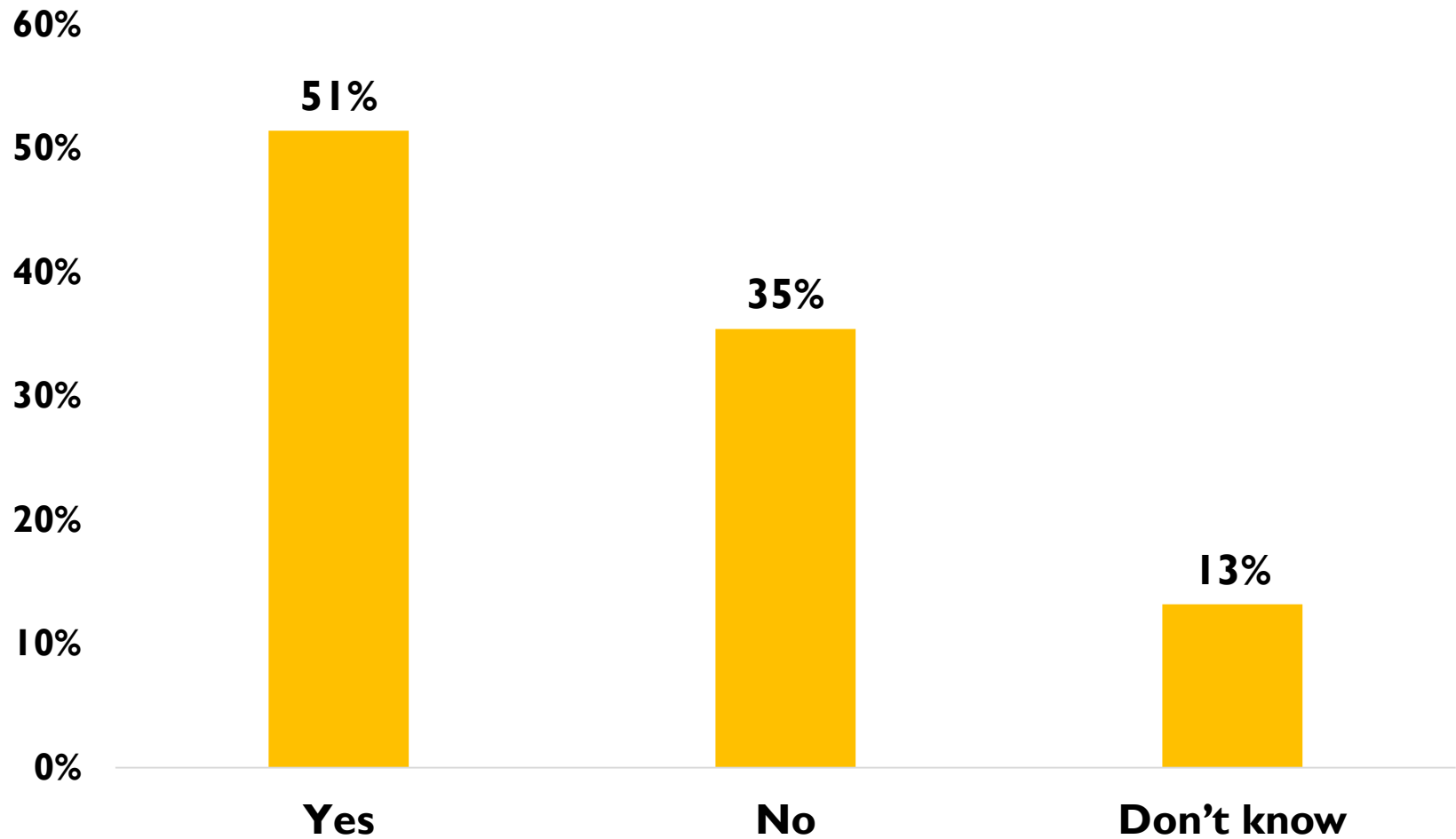

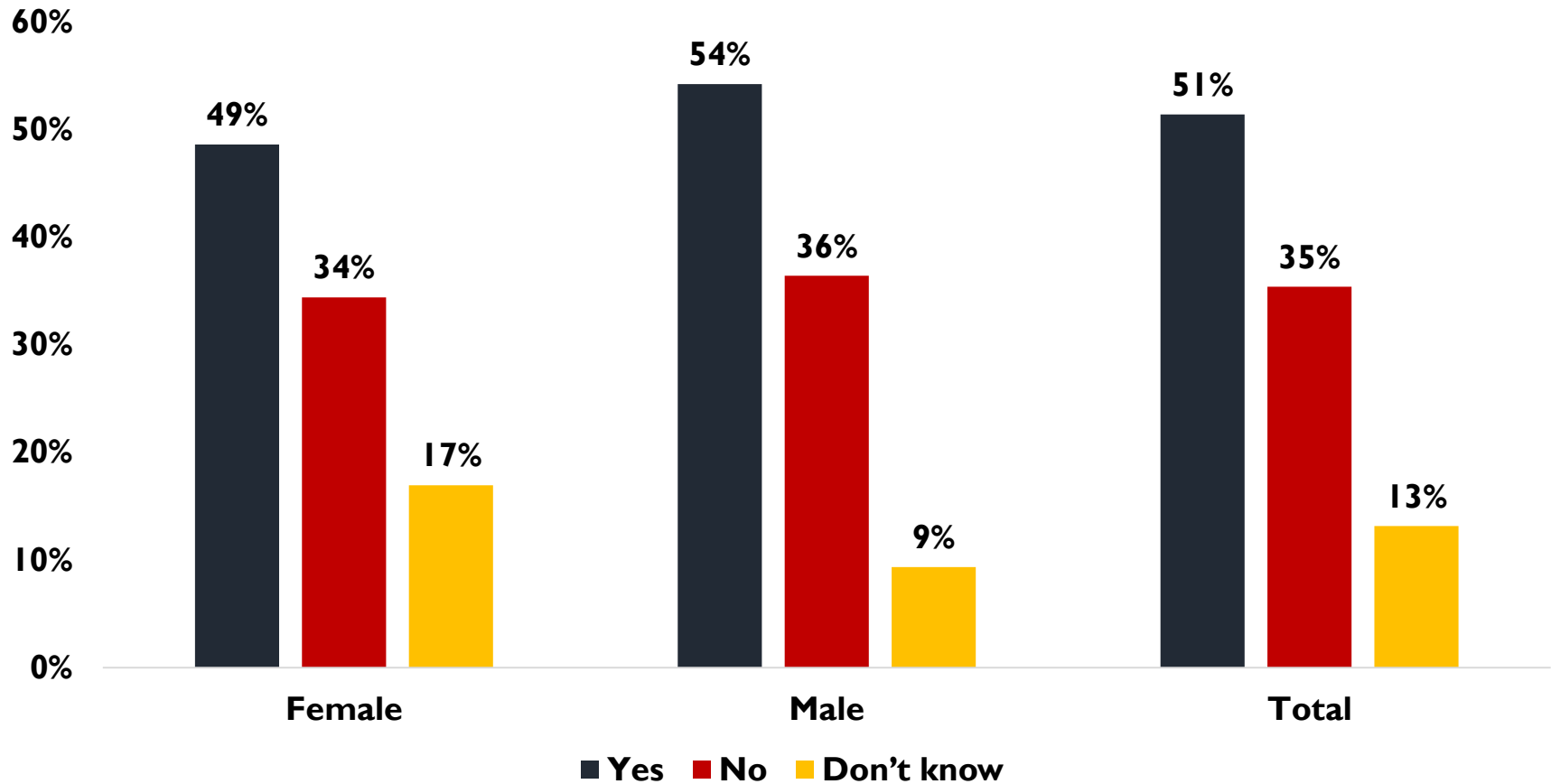

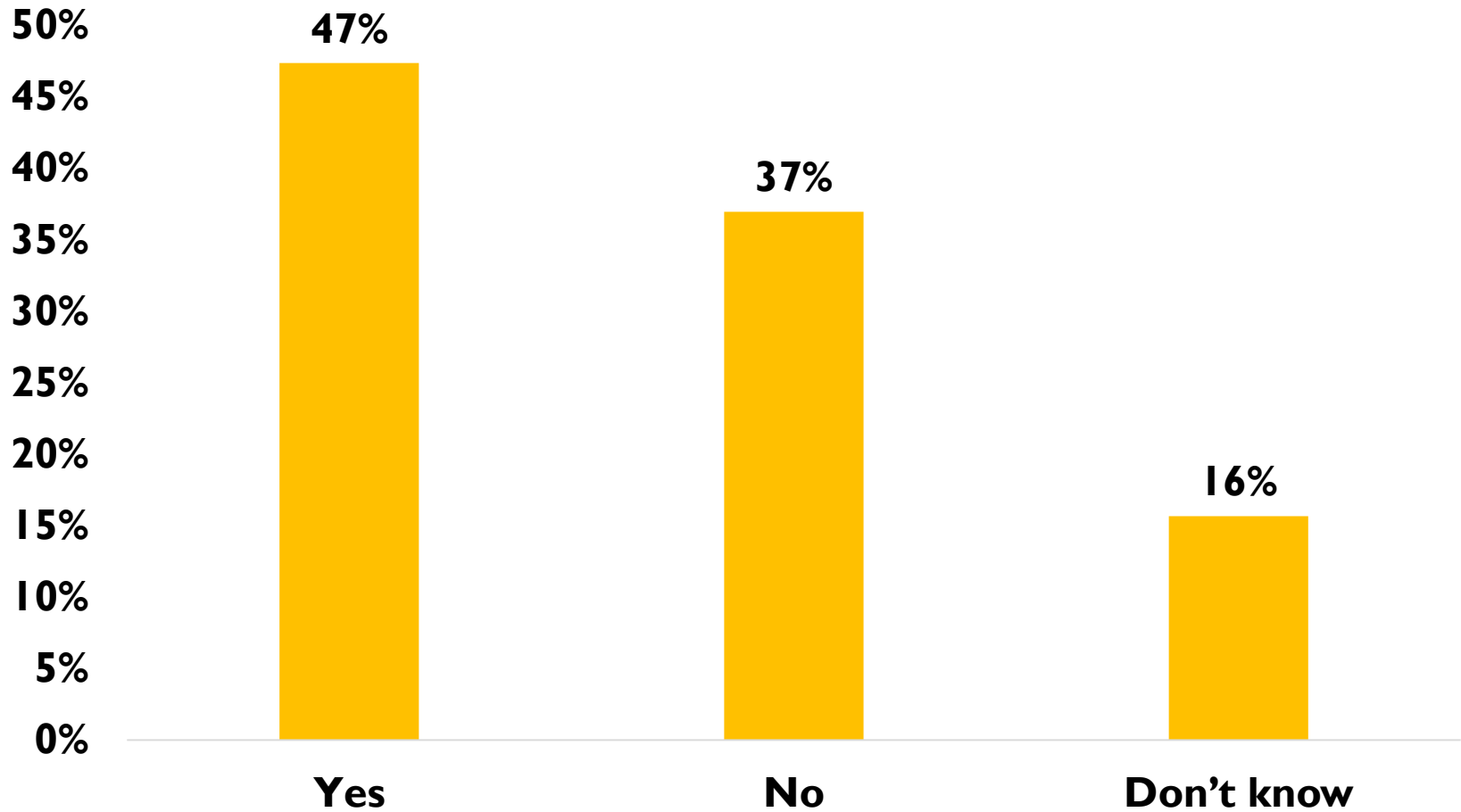

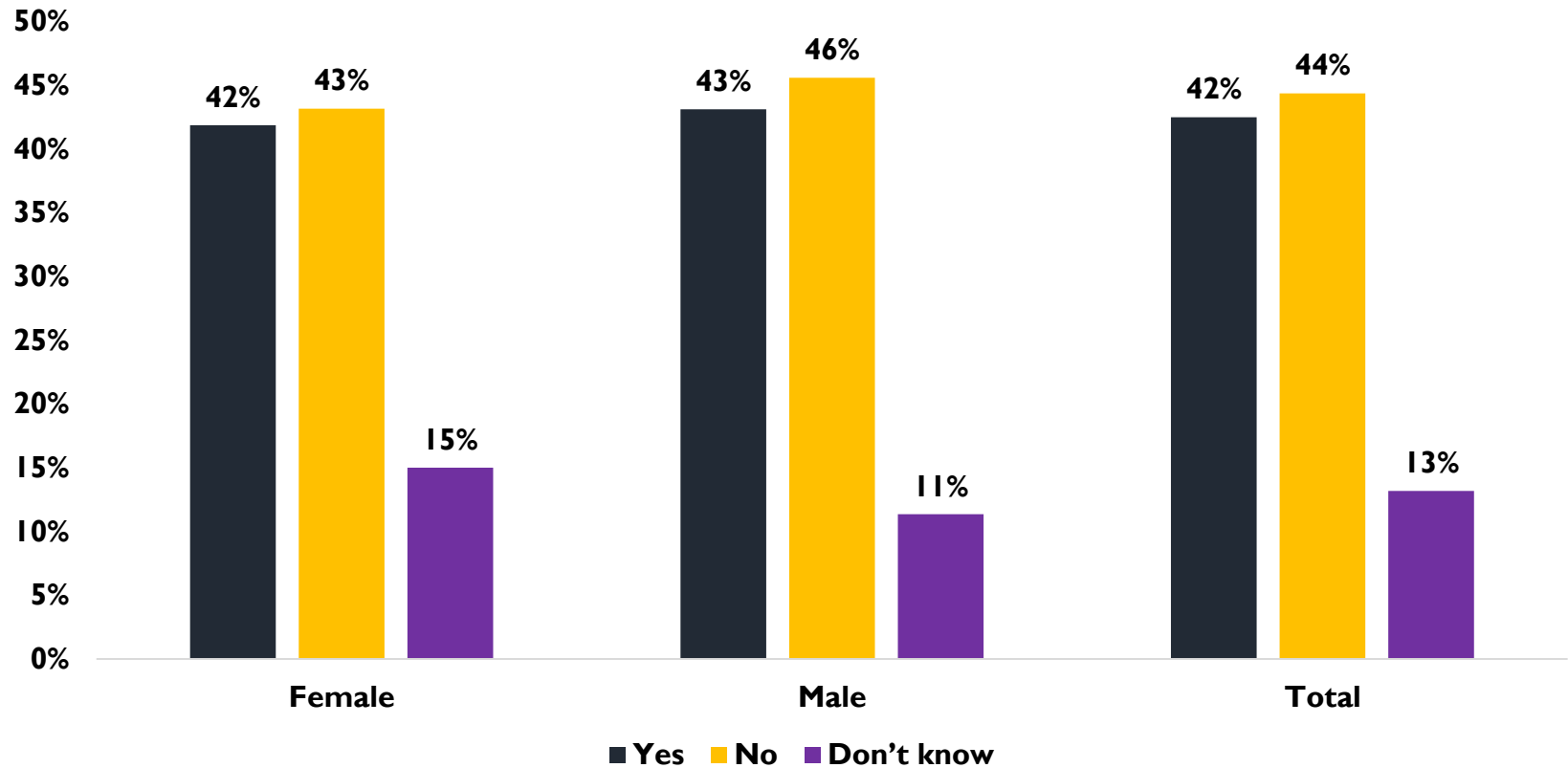

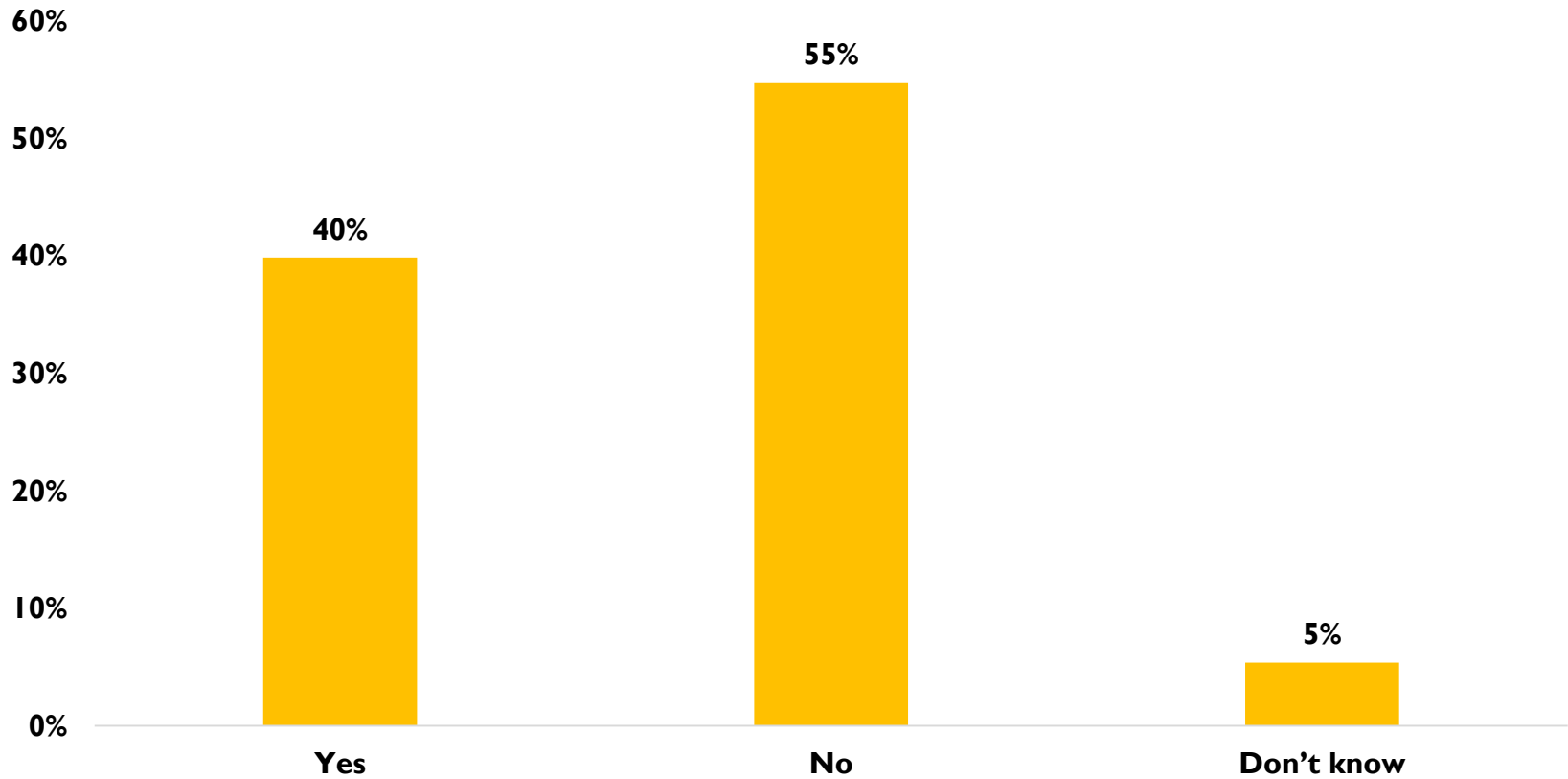

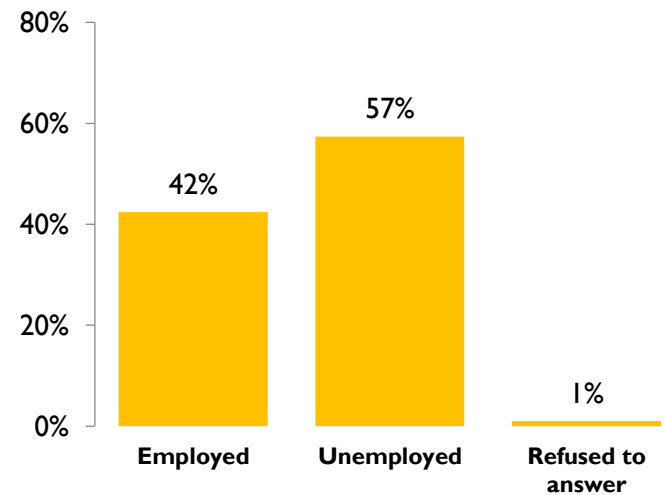
